We hope that your Thanksgiving break was relaxing, and that you had time to pause and reflect on why you are thankful.

The message below in **blue** was sent just before the break. We are sending these reminders again and ask that you read them closely. I have updated the current total percentage of our students who have reported a positive test result: 2%. Our campus was treated again with Super Virus Shield on November 7th, 2020. I am attaching the previously sent information sheet for Super Virus Shield.

If you traveled and/or were around extended family and friends over the holiday, please be especially conscientious in completing your health checks and staying home from school if needed.

Below are the quarantining guidelines we ask you to follow (from the CDC. [Link here](#)):

**10 days of quarantine:**

- Positive COVID-19 test result with symptoms
- Positive COVID -19 test result with NO symptoms

**14 days of quarantine:**

- Close contact with someone with positive COVID-19 test results

**Cold and flu season is here, and I want to remind everyone to take care of yourself, get plenty of rest, and stay home if you are not feeling well. We knew that we would have positive COVID-19 cases (just over 2% of our total student body) and communicated that it will require all of us working together to ensure we limit the spread, as much as possible. Reminders from our June 2020 Back-to-School Plan are listed below. For your reference, the full plan is attached. These best-practice guidelines are effective in preventing the spread of viruses in general.**

- **We ask that all families continue to follow the Health Checks before coming to school each day & best Hygiene Practices.**
- **Please do not attend school if you or your child is exhibiting symptoms (fever, cough, vomiting, etc.).**

**We will continue to notify parents of positive cases, in their grade level, once we receive those notifications. Remember that your child may wear a mask, should you feel that is a necessary precaution.**
