Classes include Middle School Art, Art I, Art II, and Yearbook, which requires a high level of organization, initiative, and time-management to lead school photo days and student yearbook staff. Yearbook software training is provided.

Applicants must be physically and mentally able to perform the responsibilities of the position. Additionally, they must agree with [RCA's Statement of Faith](#), be willing and able to uphold and implement RCA's policies and procedures, and create a safe, nurturing, and appropriately challenging instructional environment for all students.

Must be willing and able to fulfill the following duties:

- Prepare a variety of written materials **which includes, but is not limited to**, weekly lesson plans, assessments, grades, parent correspondence, behavior records.
- Provide free tutoring for students 30 minutes before and/or after school as needed.
- Willingness to sponsor a club, honor society, or coach an athletic program.
- Monitor, manage, and report student behavior in the classroom, cafeteria, hallways, school grounds. Classroom management must be fair, firm, consistent, and kind.
- Build positive relationships with students to ensure the classroom is a welcoming space in which students are encouraged to ask questions and communicate with the teacher.
- Implement Learning Plans, with the assistance of the Learning Specialist, for students with learning differences.
- Attend faculty meetings, and other special events, work 2 athletic gates, and participate in professional development.
- Perform other duties as assigned or directed.

Applicants should possess a high level of professionalism, a positive attitude, and the ability to communicate effectively and constructively with all stakeholders. The desire to collaborate with colleagues for the purpose of curriculum development and student success is essential. A Bachelor's degree in the subject area, education, or other related field is required. Teaching certification or master's degree is preferred, but not required.
